9. COURSE REQUIREMENT

9.1. Rules of class participation

- Students are responsible for attending all classes. There must be sufficient and reasonable proofs in case of absence from school due to force majeure reasons.

Students are responsible for actively researching documents, proactively preparing lessons before going to class according to lecturers' instructions and requests.

- Students absent more than 20% of the total number of sessions will be deemed not to complete the course and must re-register.
- Students who submit individual assignments late compared with the prescribed time of instructors will receive a score of 0 for that assignment.
- Students will be asked to answer random questions and answers throughout 12 lessons
- Regarding the exchange between lecturers and students: Encourage students to participate in discussions, give direct feedback with teachers about the module's content, teaching and learning methods, teaching and reading materials. Lecturers also encourage students to give feedback on the form, methods, and contents of the tests and evaluate students' learning results. Students can communicate with lecturers in class, during office hours, or via email. The valuable student feedback contributes to improving the teaching and learning quality of the module

9.2. Rules of classroom behavior

- The module is conducted on the principle of respect for learners and teachers. All acts that interfere with the teaching and learning process are strictly prohibited.

- Students need to actively participate in lectures in class through talking with teachers (answering and asking questions), discussing with other students in class, group discussions, case studies, presentations.
